Each year on June 20 the United Nations High Commission on Refugees (UNHCR) hosts World Refugee Day events in order to draw the public's attention to the millions of refugees worldwide who have been forced to flee their homes due to war, conflict and persecution. The annual commemoration is marked by a variety of events in more than 100 countries, involving government officials, humanitarian aid workers, celebrities, civilians and the refugees themselves.
