3. How did you react to the statistics included in the publication? Did they surprise you or make you think of the issue in a different way?
4. What do we celebrate after 5 years of the Sustainable Development Goals?
5. In UNANIMA International we believe in you, our Grassroots Members and your ability to collaborate around a common need to make a positive change locally for our world, how have you done this in relation to the SDGs and/or Family Homelessness?
